Show rules and conditions of entry

1. Stallions/colts may not be led by any junior who is under the age of 14 years.
2. The Judges decision is final.
3. All Stallions and 2/3 year old colts must hold a current license and passport.
4. Spurs are not allowed in any M & M ridden classes.
5. Show canes or whips are not to exceed 30ins in lead rein classes. Plain or leather covered canes may only be used.
6. Correctly fitting hats to the following standards WN1384, PASO15:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 , AMERICAN STANDARD SNELL E2001 , ASTM96, SNZ3838 1998 must be worn at all times when mounted.
7. Objections in writing to the secretary with in 1 hour of the event concerned and lodged at the office along with a sum of £25.00 deposit. The sum shall be returned if the objection is sustained.
8. No exhibitor may enter and compete with an animal under a judge who is known to have sold, produced or received financial gain.
9. Trained first aiders will be present on the show field.
10. All riders are requested to proceed at walking pace when mingling with spectators.
11. The organisers or any person acting on their behalf do not accept liability for any injuries or accidents to persons, animals or loss/damage to property.
12. The organisers have the right to refuse entry to the show ground or the property as a whole without disclosing a reason for doing so.
13. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
14. All litter should be taken home or placed in the bins provided.
15. Abuse of a horse / pony will result in immediate elimination.
16. Rudeness or disobedience to any judge , steward or official will result with immediate disqualification from being judged.
17. Acceptance of the foregoing provisions shall be a condition of entry.
18. NARC operates a child protection policy and has a welfare officer available.
19. All horses and ponies must hold a passport and should be made available to view at any time.
20. There will be a photographer on the show field taking pictures of the day's events. Some of these photos could be used on the website. If you do not wish yourself or your Childs photo to be put on the website please approach the photographer and make him aware of this. Thank You.
