

Show rules & Conditions of Entry

1. Stallions / Colts may not be led by any junior who has not attained their 14th Birthday before the 1st Jan in the current year.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. All stallions and 2/3 year old colts must hold a current license and passport.
4. Spurs are not allowed in any M & M ridden class.
5. Show canes or whips are not to exceed 30". In lead rein classes plain or leather covered canes may only be used.
6. Correctly fitting hats to the following standards, BS4472, 6473, PAS015 or EN1384 must be worn at all times when mounted.
7. Objections in writing to the secretary within 1 hour of the event concerned and lodged with the office along with £25.00 deposit. The sum shall be returned if objection is sustained.
8. No exhibitor may enter and compete with an animal under a judge who is known to have sold, produced or received financial gain from that animal.
9. Trained first aiders will be present.
10. All riders are requested to proceed at walking pace when mingling with spectators.
11. The organisers or any persons acting on their behalf do not accept liability for any injuries or accidents to persons, animals or any loss or damage to property.
12. The organizers have the right to refuse entry to the show ground or the property as a whole without disclosing a reason for doing so.
13. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
14. All litter should be taken home or placed in the bins provided.
15. Abuse of a horse or pony will result in immediate elimination.
16. Rudeness or disobedience to any judge, steward or official will result in immediate disqualification from being judge.
17. Acceptance of the foregoing provisions shall be a condition of entry.
18. NARC operates a child protection policy and has a child protection officer available.
19. All horses and ponies must hold a passport that can be made available to view at any time.

Clear Round Jumping 9.00am - 9.30am (horses)

Clear Round Jumping 1.30pm - 2.00pm (ponies)

Horses: 9.30am Prompt.

Class 1: Beginner Stakes fences not to exceed 45cm
Riders cannot compete in any other class.

Class 2: Novice - Novice fences not to exceed 65cm
in first round.

Class 3: Novice fences not to exceed 75cm in the
first round.

Class 4: Intermediate fences not to exceed 85cm in the first round.

Class Open fences not to exceed 95cm in the first round.

Ponies

Class 6: Wobblies cross poles only. Riders cannot compete in any other class.

Class 7: Novice - Novice fences not to exceed 55cm in first round.

Class 8: Novice fences not to exceed 65cm in the first round.

Class 9: Intermediate fences not to exceed 75cm in the first round.

Class 10: Open fences not to exceed 90cm in the first round.

There will be a CHAPS Qualifier for 55cm , 65cm,75cm and 90cm. Please just let the entries secretary know if you wish to enter the horse or pony classes. These are for members of CHAPS only.

North Ayrshire Riding Club Members Trophy will be awarded to the member with the highest points accumulated on the day.

Points System: 1st = 6points , 2nd = 5 points
decreasing in order.
