Hunter Series .Open to mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cm and must not have won Â £150 or more in BSJA classes nor have more than 3 BE points. Riders 17 years or over on the day of the competition. Eight to twelve fences approximately 3'3" in height. Classes will be judged in line with the Sports Horse Breeding Society of Great Brita in Rules, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.sporthorsegb.co.uk. Riding hats to be in accordance with the current BRC Rule Book. The first THREE prizewinners will qualify for the Final to be held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 26th August 2010. To be eligible for the qualifying rounds and final the rider must be a member of a Riding Club affiliated to BRC. The first three riders will be handed a postcard to fill in and send off to the Blair Castle Horse Trials Office with their entry fee for the Final. In the event of one of the qualifiers having already qualified, the postcard will be handed down the line to the fourth prizewinner provided they have a clear round in the jumping phase.

- 1: CHEQUES SHOULD BE CROSSED AND MADE PAYBLE TO NARC.NO TELE OR EMAIL ENTRIES ACCEPTED. ALL LATE ENTRIES ON THE DAY WILL BE SUBJECT TO A LATE ENTRY FEE
- 2: THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SPLIT OR COMBINE ENTRES IF THERE ARE OVER OR UNDER SUBSCRIBED CLASSES.
- 3:THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO THE SHOW FIELD WITHOUT DISCLOSING A REASON FOR DOING SO.
- 4: LATE ENTRIES TO CLASSES WILL ONY BE ALLOWED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE.THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
- 5: ALL HORSES AND PONIES MUST HOLD A CURRENT PASSPORT. IT IS ADVISABLE TO CARRY THIS WITH YOU AS TRADING STANDARDS CAN ASK TO VIEW IT AT ANY TIME.
- 6: CORRECTLY FITTING HATS TO THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS, BS4472, 6473, PAS015, OR EN1384 MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED.
